3. Non Pro exhibitors may enter both the Open and Non Pro Derby. If cross entering, the Non Pro must show in the Open division.
4. Derby is one go. RMRHA retains 50% of entry fees.

2026 Summer Slide Maturity

1. Open to horses eight and over. Payout Schedule B
2. Horses to be shown one handed in any legal NRHA bit.
3. Maturity is one go. RMRHA retains 50% of entry fees.

General Show Conditions & Information

1. **Stalls:** A total of 32 aisle front sponsor stalls are available and will be sold at \$500 each on a first come first served basis. Charges for stall front sponsorships will be added to tabs. Aisle fronts **ARE NOT** available except as listed above. **Includes stall front only and does not include attached stall.** Sponsor stall front purchasers will receive:

- * Banner space in the warm-up arena. Banner to be furnished by sponsor.
- * One year listing on the RMRHA website as a Summer Slide Sponsor.
- * Announcements throughout the horse show as an event sponsor.

Regular Stall fees are \$350 for the entire show and include 4 bags of shavings; day stalls are not available. For stalls and stall front sponsorships, contact Jana Day at 208.681.1320. Bedding available for purchase on the grounds. No outside shavings permitted. We will have grass hay and alfalfa available at the show grounds. Grain options are available through nearby feed stores.

2. **Office Charge:** \$60/head for all horses. **Exhibitors submitting horse & rider information after June 23 will be charged an additional \$25/head office charge** **NRHA Drug Fee:** \$35/head **Media Fee:** \$25/run (Includes your video via videographer's website.)

Arrival and Check-In: Arrival on the show grounds is restricted until after 12:00 p.m., Friday, July 3. All exhibitors must vacate stalls by 6:00 AM on Sunday, July 12.

3. **Area Hotels:** These are not host hotels and are listed for information only. Embassy Suites 970.593.6200, Holiday Inn Express, 970.663.0057, Springhill Suites, 888.420.1641. There are also many other hotels in the vicinity and Loveland area. **Make reservations early.**

4. **RV Hookups:** Full hookup sites are available. All spaces are 20, 30 or 50 amp with a majority being 50 amp. Additionally, dump station and water fill is available. Reservations must be made at: <https://www.campspot.com/book/the-ranch>.

5. **RELEASE OF LIABILITY:** All participants are fully aware, completely understand and accept that participation in the RMRHA Summer Slide (the "Event") whether as a contestant, employee, volunteer, exhibitor, sponsor or spectator is dangerous and the Events and activities associated with, relating to, arising out of and concerning this participation present substantial, serious and real risks of personal injury or death to the undersigned participant and the loss of, damage to, or destruction of the undersigned participant's personal property. Under Colorado law, an equine professional, including RMRHA is not liable for an injury to or the death of a participant in activities resulting from the inherent risks of equine activities pursuant to section 13-21-119, Colorado Revised Statutes. All participants by entering this Event, fully and completely assume these substantial, serious and real risks whether or not apparent, known, unknown, foreseen, unforeseen, present or contingent, and the design or designing, staging supervising, maintaining or in any way presenting, conducting or sponsoring the Event. **By entering this Event, all participants agree to waive, release, indemnify and hold harmless RMRHA, it's agents and employees from all claims, damages, losses, injuries and expenses arising out of or resulting from participation in the Event. All participants further agree to release, acquit and covenant not to sue RMRHA, it's agents and employees for all actions, causes of actions, damage or damages in law or remedies in equity of whatever kind.**

6. **Stallion, Gelding and Mare Class Rules:** Horses entered must be of the correct gender. Any horse may be shown only once. May be ridden one handed or two handed in any NRHA legal bit or NRHA legal snaffle or hackamore. No training equipment allowed in the arena. Time limit to be determined according to the number of entries & timed by announcer starting when the horse has walked through the gate. Exhibitor will be excused from arena at the end of allotted time.

Exhibitors are responsible for knowledge of NRHA rules and are subject to same. This show adheres to NRHA rules with the following additions:

7. Entries for all classes each day will close at **3:00 p.m.** the day before (except futurity classes, see futurity conditions). Exhibitors submitting entries after any announced closing time for any class, whether the draw has been posted or not, will draw their own working position (first or last).

8. Show tabs will be put in the name of the responsible party according to the name listed on the entry form. Government 1099 forms will be issued accordingly, unless specified otherwise at the show. Premium checks will be issued in the name of the responsible party as listed on the show tab. No changes to 1099's will be permitted after the last day of the show. **Social Security number or tax I.D. must be provided before checks will be issued.**

9. Payment for show tabs will be accepted in the form of cash or negotiable check or credit card. A \$50 fee will be added to all short checks. Credit card payment accepted with a 4% handling fee.

10. **No phone entries will be accepted for any class. No entry will be accepted without competition license number & NRHA membership number.**

11. All prizes are awarded on an as is basis and are not redeemable for cash or exchangeable.

12. **All drags are determined pursuant to NRHA rules and as determined by show management. No changes to the assigned drags will be made after class draws are finalized.**

13. If a competitor enters more than one class that does not run concurrently, the competitor will be required to show in each class.

14. **Health Certificate:** A 30-day health certificate written by a veterinarian at the point of origin (out of state must have current Coggins) to be presented upon arrival at The Ranch. Please be sure health certificates accompany the horses.

15. If/when ordering additional bedding, splits on shavings tabs must be done in the show office upon arrival. Refunds cannot be issued on shavings once they have been delivered to the stalling area.

16. **Please note,** arena maintenance may not be performed between the hours of midnight and 5:00 due to facility staffing levels. Overnight riding may be restricted or not allowed to maintain the highest possible footing quality. Hours and rules will be posted as soon as they are available. We sincerely apologize for any associated inconvenience.

17. To fully support the professionals who photograph our events and ensure that their wonderful services are available, the use of professional recording devices (cameras with a lens that is over 2 inches) is strictly prohibited with the only exception being owners photographing their own equine athletes. Media passes will be available at the show office.

2026 RMRHA Summer Slide Open & Guy Vernon Memorial NonPro Futurity Conditions

Divisions offered: Open 1, 2, and 4, NonPro Level 4. NonPro Level 1 is not NRHA approved. **All show conditions will apply to the futurity when applicable. The futurity will adhere to NRHA rules with the following additions:**

1. Eligibility for the futurity will be limited to foals of 2023. This is an NRHA category 2 approved event.
2. Horses may be shown two handed in a NRHA legal snaffle or hackamore or one handed in any NRHA legal bit at rider's discretion.
3. The Open divisions of the futurity will be run separate from the NonPro divisions of the futurity. Scores from the NonPro Futurity cannot be used in the Open Futurity. The first go for the Open will be Wednesday for all Open divisions. The Open Futurity finals are scheduled for Saturday. The NonPro will be one-go, Thursday.
4. **NOTE !!** In order to enter any division below Level 4 in the open futurity, you must enter the next step up, i.e. to enter Level 2, you must enter Level 4, in order to enter Level 1, you must enter Level 2, etc. If entering only the NonPro Level 1, entering up is not required. **Cross entries (Nonpro entering the Open) must run in each respective session, Open on Wednesday and Nonpro on Thursday.**
5. **NOTE !!** In all Open divisions, the top 25% of entries but not less than 30 head will return for the finals based on first go scores. The Open is a clean slate final.
6. Open Draw Party for finalists, **presented by Mr Fahrenheit**, will be held Thursday afternoon. Time will be announced/posted.
7. Open prizes for all divisions of each futurity will be awarded following the Open finals and scores have been verified. Nonpro prizes will be awarded following the Open class Thursday, anticipated to be during the lunch break.
8. Paybacks will be awarded 40% on the first go and 60% on the finals in the Open. RMRHA will retain 50% of entry fees.
9. **Entries are due June 20, 2026.** Late entries will be accepted with a \$150 per horse late charge until 1:00 p.m. Tuesday, July 7. The draw will be posted by 6:00 p.m. Tues, July 7 for both futurities.
10. For concurrent classes, only one judges fee is required per run. The highest judges fee in the set of concurrent classes will apply.
11. Refunds: If scratched prior to 1:00 PM July 7, 2026, a refund will be granted for all entry fees minus the office fee. No refunds for Futurity entries after 1:00 PM, July 7.

2026 Rocky Mountain Summer Slide Stallion Stakes Futurity Conditions

Divisions Offered: Open Level 4. NonPro Level 4. All show conditions shall apply to the Stallion Stakes when applicable. The Stallion Stakes will adhere to NRHA and RMRHA Futurity rules with the following changes:

1. This is a NRHA category 6 approved event. RMRHA will retain 50% of entry fees
2. In the Open divisions, the top 25% of entries will return for the finals based on first go scores. A minimum of 30 entries will return to a clean slate final in the Open Division. The NonPro will be one-go.
3. RMRHA will collect a \$25.00 fee on each paid entry to the Open and NonPro Stallion Stakes division of the Summer Slide Futurity. This entire fee will be paid to the stallion owner, or the nominator if stallion is a late nomination.
4. **Late Stallion Eligibility:** Stallion owners wishing to ensure the get of their stallions are eligible for the current year's Stallion Stakes Futurity, must **NOMINATE** and **PAY** no later than **June 1, 2026. This deadline is firm and no exceptions will be made.** The cost is one- and one-half times the advertised stud fee the year the foal was conceived. 5. A Sire Nomination Award is presented to the nominator of Stallion of the winning get. The Sire Award for 2026 is \$8,141. and is split 50/50 between the nominators of the Open and NonPro winning get.
6. **The get of the following 2022 (foaled 2023) enrolled stallions are eligible to compete as three-year-olds in the 2026 Stallion Stakes Futurity:**
